Short History of Your Activity:

• **Starting Year:** I started formal teaching activity as employee in 2019, but till then, as organizer of the Timisoara Go Club meetings I was there to great new persons interested in learning how to play the game. I organized first introductory Go classes in 2001.

• Highlights:

- 2001, first attempt for organized Go classes at the Timisoara Club.
- 2003, first promo activity of Go in rural area, in Stanciova.

- 2005, started to assist mr. Viorel Arsinoaia in teaching smaller children (6 to 8 years) at after-school club "Tema" in Timisoara.
- 2017, started to assist mr. Zamfir Moldovan in teaching primary school children in rural area, in Giroc community.
- 2019, developed a teaching method for introducing kindergarten kids to Go (5-6 years old), in rural community Dudestii Noi.
- 2022, developed method for beginners Module 1 for children and young adults (introduction and 9x9).
- 2023, developed method for beginners Module 2 for children and young adults (making the transition to 19x19).

For kindergarten it is 2 hours semi free space where I mix Go with other two board games Quarto and Quoridor, and with Lego of course.
- **Lesson Frequency:** weekly, in modules of 4 lessons. Several modules per year. I have 2 beginners modules: one for absolute newcomers and another for beginners. The kindergarten lessons are also weekly.
