How Can NA or EGF Help Improve Local Activity:

- More official competitions dedicated mainly to the ages under 14 are needed.
- Go instructors should be helped to improve their own level in Go.

Challenges Encountered:

- The main problem is the lack of Go instructors in the territory.
- Another serious problem is the lack of qualified Go arbiters. Without them, we cannot organise official tournaments in small towns and villages.
- Regional phases of the national Go championaships for kids and juniors are also needed, in order to allow a much higher number of kids to participate in national official competitions and obtain medals which may leverage a higher support from local authorities, sponsors, parents and local community.
